Dr Thomas Finke elected for a term of two years

Dr Thomas Finke, Head of Product Group Heat Pumps and Managing Director Bosch Thermoteknik AB, Tranås, Sweden, has been elected as a member of the board of the European Heat Pump Association. With the aim of drawing attention to the relevance of heat pumps for a CO₂-neutral Europe as well as laying the foundation for sustainable growth of the heat pump industry, the EHPA represents numerous companies within the European heat pump industry.

Thomas Finke has been supporting the association's board since November 2020. He has been elected for an initial period of two years. "My goal is to support the EHPA in its necessary transformation to a business alliance.
